Thank you for choosing Emory University Hospital Midtown for the birth of your child. Our focus is to provide you and your family with an excellent childbirth experience. The following information will help guide and inform you and your family as you prepare for your upcoming birth.

1. Pre-registration

We encourage you to pre-register. Pre-registration forms are available in your physician's office, and at the Maternity Center registration desk located on the 3rd floor of the Medical Office Tower (MOT). The form can be returned directly to Maternity Registration or faxed to 404-686-4180. Please make sure all information is filled out on the form. If you send your form by fax, please include a copy of your driver's license and insurance card or bring them with you if you are registering in person. If you have a living will or advance directive be sure to provide a copy for the registration staff.

3. Parking and Admissions

Our address is 550 Peachtree St. Atlanta, GA 30308. Park in the high-rise (Summit) parking deck, which can be accessed from either Peachtree Street or West Peachtree Street. Walk across the skywalk located on Level "F" of the parking deck. Take the elevator located on this level to the 3rd floor where Labor & Delivery is located. Check in at the registration desk as you exit the elevator. There is a flat fee for parking in a 24-hour period.
